


The Alder

Our Select Private Family Funeral (Prior to Burial)



A private gathering of family at our Service Hall, followed by full service at the Crematorium Chapel & Burial Combining intimacy with a public event Supportive, initial time Full public service to include friends Optional Webcast Service to include distant family Includes all essential elements & our complimentary touches When you need to cling to family, but also to include a wider circle Creates a memorable and heartfelt tribute to your loved one

The Alder: A Supportive Family Gathering followed by a Burial Service to include friends

A supportive funeral, that hosts family at our private Service Hall on the funeral day, to allow viewing if required, or just to gather out of the public glare and greet arriving family from a distance. OR the time might be used to personalise a card coffin, listen to music together, watch a photo carousel – and gather strength from each other. The Service takes place at the Crematorium Chapel, where we then process prior to Burial, to join the wider circle of friends.

This funeral includes:

- Arrangement during business hours at home or at our premises and liaison on your behalf with GPs
- A wood veneer dignified, fully furnished coffin
- Purchase of new grave plot if required and opening for one
- Solid oak marker cross with engraved plate
- All care, professional services and all third party fees
- Our classic motor hearse, use of our Service Hall for family to gather, procession from thereto the Crematorium Chapel and full staff
- The services of our Celebrant (Christian or Humanist)
- A complimentary online tribute page to keep and share for notice, donations, memories, virtual candles
- Enlarged keepsake photograph/optional life story carousel
- Ordering of your music choices
- Optional Webcast service for distant family to participate
- Single roses for family & wooden shapes for children
- Hand crafted flower cards with orders from our florist
- Access to free professional counselling

Total Cost

£4,381 (open coffin where grave with space exists) £5,706 (open coffin inclusive of purchase of new grave plot)

With prior viewing for you to spend time with your loved one. Full embalming and restoration is included.

Please deduct £230 if a closed coffin, with no viewing is the preferred option.

Options and what is not included

- Additional viewing visits/key access £20
- A newspaper notice is not included allow £150 approx if you wish to add this on
- Floral tributes are not included but we have our own florist who is able to help with your choices.
- Use of our limousines may be added at £230 per limousine
- Removal of existing headstone where applicable will be quoted by our mason following survey
- Order of Service are not included but may be added on price on request.

How the Funeral is invoiced

Where grave space exists, a deposit of £1,750 is required four days prior to the funeral.

Where grave space does not exist, a deposit of £2,750 is required 4 days prior to the funeral.

Guaranteed funds E.g. full insurance, full funds in estate: providing these are evidenced, the deposit may be waived, as long as settlement is within the terms.

Non-guaranteed funds E.g. DWP Funeral Claims or Crowd funding: the deposit is required, along with the agreement of a guarantor who will settle the balance should the claim be refused.

Advance full payment discount

Should you opt to settle the balance in full in advance of the funeral, we will deduct £100 as a thank you for prompt settlement.
